**Secretaries Report  
November 2014**

The OBBS adopted the 2014 NEC at their meeting last month, with an effective date of January 2015. This adoption (and effective date) applies to all occupancies governed by the Ohio Building Code (commercial, industrial & residential (excludes 1, 2 & 3 family dwellings)).

The IAEI and a coalition will need to develop a new petition, to propose updating the Residential Code of Ohio (1, 2 & 3 family dwellings). This will follow the same process that the OBC, OMC & OPC has, except we will also need to seek endorsement from the Residential Construction Advisory Committee (RCAC), before the OBBS will take action to adopt.

All Western Reserve Division Code Classes have been approved by the BBS for the 2015 Fiscal Year. I have been working on this for the last few months with help from Bill Buetler. We had to make sure we didn't get caught at the end of the year with the Board not having it on their slate.

This is a code change year in Ohio so renewal is not option using the same classes as last year. All new 2014 Classes had to be developed.
