Scholarship Information May 1, 2014

1. Qualification requirements:

- Currently graduating Senior of High School and son, daughter, grandchild, or Legal Ward of a member of the Ohio Chapter I.A.E.I.
- Enrolled or planning to enroll in any two or four year accredited institution of higher learning.
- The applicant is not required to pursue the field of electricity. All fields will be considered.

2. Selection :

- Applicants will be judged on the basis of financial need, academics, honors/recognition, extra curricular activities, personal recommendations of teachers/others, essay on future plans, and work experience.

3. Award: Four [4] scholarships in the amount of \$1000.00 each will be awarded.

This award will be applied towards tuition and/or room and board only. One payment will be made to the registrar or bursar of the chosen institution in the first year.

- This scholarship applies to the first year only and is non renewable.
- The scholarship recipient will be notified by letter. Their name will be read at the Annual Ohio Chapter Meeting and the award will be presented individually at the respective Division Meeting
